Texas Medicaid helps over 4 million Texans receive the care and support they need to get healthy, stay healthy and live life to the fullest as members of their communities.

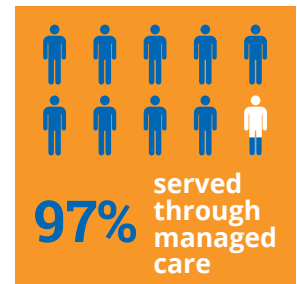

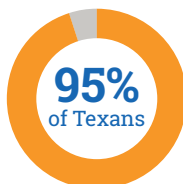

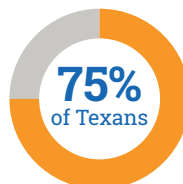

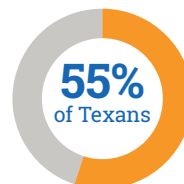


believe it is important to have a strong, sustainable Medicaid program

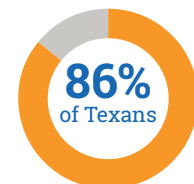


oppose cutting the Medicaid program
